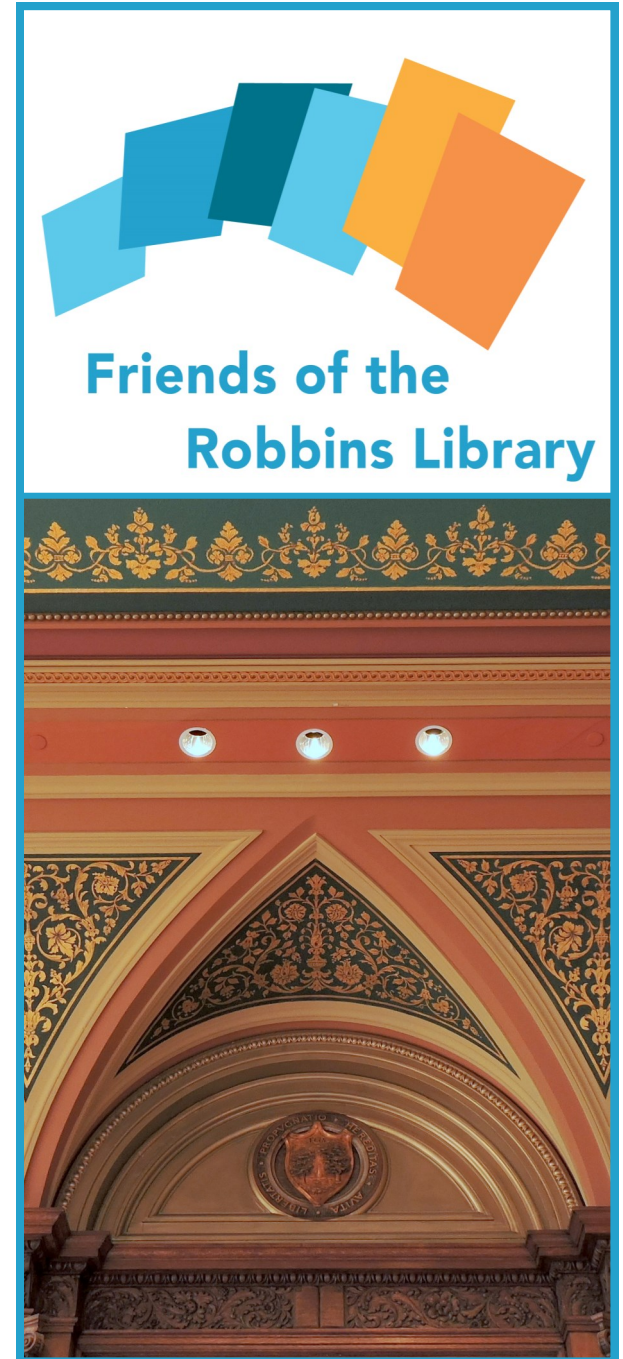
In tough economic times public libraries need private donations more than ever, since citizen requests for materials and services exceed the funds available through the municipal budget.
