MINUTES OF THE MEETING

February 25, 1961

A group of about forty "friends" met in the catalog room of the library, on Saturday morning, February 25, 1961 at ten o'clock. The meeting was opened by Mrs. Spengler, chairman of the Board of Trustees, who greeted the group in behalf of the trustees and outlined the purpose of the meeting. She said it was hoped that those present would form a nucleus out of which might develop a larger group devoted to the objective of National Library Week - to work "For a better-read, betterinformed America". She spoke of the library's plans for participating in the observance of this week and announced that the trustees had procured Emily Kimbrough and Cleveland Amory as speakers at an affair to be held at the Senior High School auditorium on Wednesday evening, April 12, 1961.

Mrs. Spengler also stated that the trustees had guaranteed the fees for the speakers, to be paid for out of a trust fund and said they had also decided to charge an entrance fee, because it had been demonstrated that people appreciate things more for which they have to pay. She asked for the assistance of the "friends" in promoting the sale of tickets and in publicity. Mrs. Spengler then introduced Mr. Washburn, who, she said, had agreed to serve as chairman of the affair.
